



WHAT VACCINATIONS HAS MY PUPPY HAD?

Vaccine/Medication Schedule Coots at Eversden

We believe it is very important to vaccinate the puppies with a strict regime to ensure they start off their life as they mean to go on with protection from the main diseases that can effect dogs.

We use only the best vaccines manufactured by Merck Sharpe Dome (MSD) called Novibac and they are known to be the best in the business.

Puppy Regime

20 days old - Drontal Puppy Suspension - this is a wormer that eradicates any intestinal parasites that could be present. We also worm the mother with a Drontal tablet. As we regularly worm all our adults every 12 weeks it is very rare that our puppies have worms.

40 Days old - next round of Drontal puppy as well as DP Plus - Novibac - this is the first injection given and protects against Parvo Virus and Distemper. It is the best medication on the market.

Nobivac DP Plus is a veterinary vaccine used to protect dogs against two separate infections caused by canine distemper virus and canine parvovirus.

Nobivac DP Plus contains the active substances live attenuated (weakened) canine distemper virus (CDV) and canine parvovirus (CPV).

The vaccine date and information on the batch is placed into the dogs passport.



At 60 days old the second vaccine is administered

Nobivac DHPPi provides immunisation of dogs against canine distemper, hepatitis (canine adenovirus), canine parvovirus and canine parainfluenza. It is recommended that puppies may be immunised from 6 weeks of age, 2-4 weeks apart, with a second dose from 10 weeks of age. The onset of immunity for canine distemper virus, canine adenovirus and canine parvovirus is 1 week after the second vaccination in a primary vaccination course. The onset of immunity for canine parainfluenza virus is 4 weeks. In dogs over 10 weeks of age or older a single dose is likely to be sufficient to establish active immunity to canine distemper, infectious canine hepatitis and canine parvovirus.

Immunity provided against these core diseases is long lasting, with a minimum duration of immunity recommended revaccination interval of 3 years, however it is recommended that dogs be vaccinated against canine parainfluenza virus every year.



At 90 days old the final vaccinations are given including parasite treatments and then the puppy is fully immunized. Not many breeders ensure that all vaccinations are given before the dog enters their new home. We believe it is essential.

Please be assured your dog does not need any further vaccines for at least one year of the final injection and treatments for parasites for 3 months.

Final Drontal worming tablet to complete the puppy course.

Nexgard Spectra to ensure no other possible parasites are present - ticks/fleas etc

Novibac Rabies RL - This is Rabies and Lepto 2 immunisation and a final Novibac DHPPi booster

Description:

Vaccine for dogs against Rabies and canine leptospirosis caused by *L. interrogans* serotype canicola and icterohaemorrhagiae

Composition:

Each dose contains:

Rabies strain Pasture RIV inducing more than 3 IU

Leptospira canicola (strain Ca-12-000) \geq 40 hamster PD80

Leptospira icterohaemorrhagiae (strain 820k) \geq 40 hamster PD80.



All the above treatments are recorded in the dogs passport. We also provide a Brucellosis test result to ensure no veterinary can refuse treatment as the dog was not born in the UK.

Approximate Cost of our Vaccination and Parasite treatment regime
If you went to the local vet for the above treatments this is what you would expect to pay:

Wormer Drontal puppy x 2 - 30.00

Drontal tablet x 1 - 5.00

DP Plus vaccination - 70.00

DHPPi x 2 - 150.00

Novibac RL - 80.00

Bucellosis test - 150.00

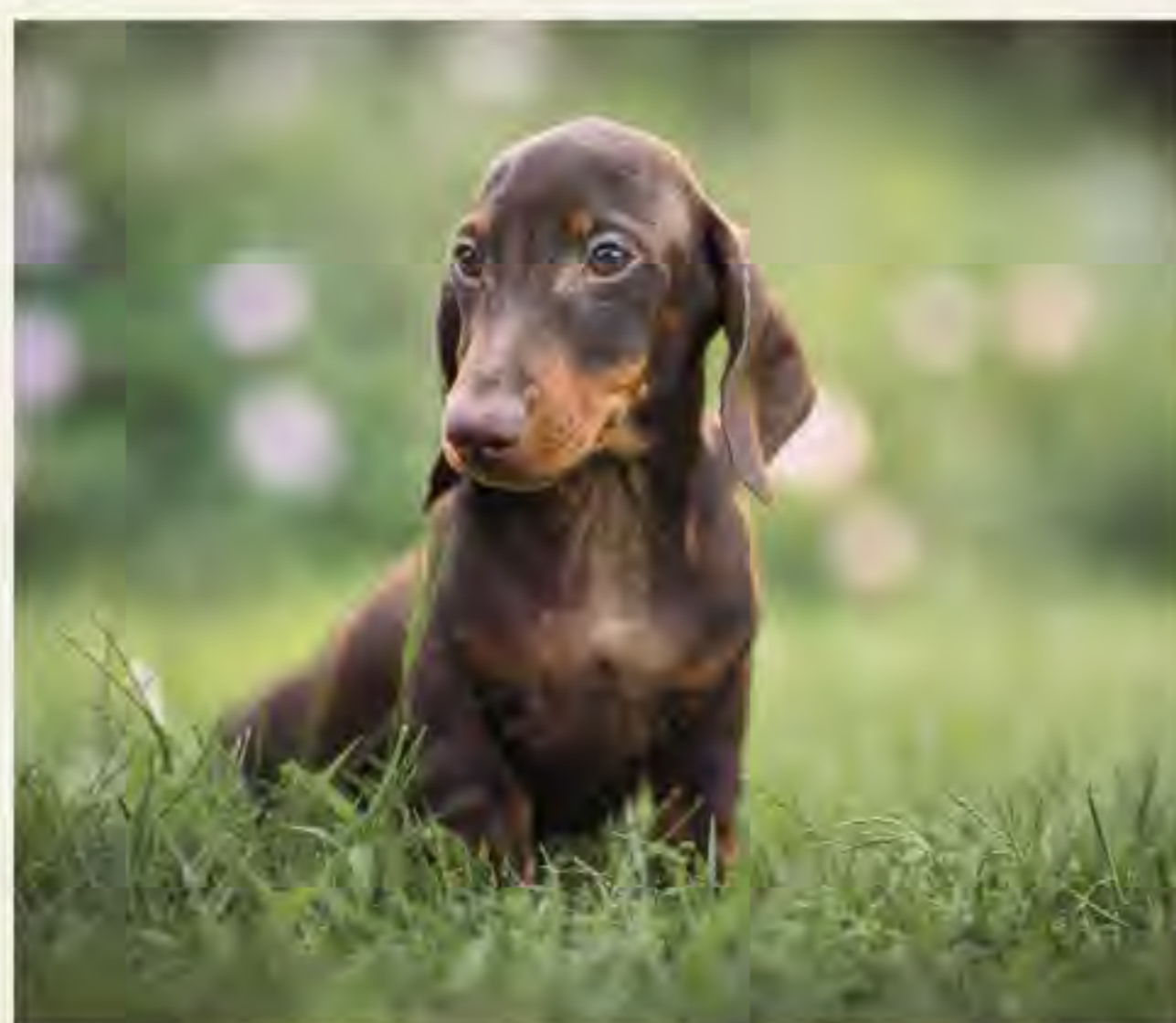
Nexgard Spectra - 55.00

Passport and Microchip - 50.00 - our dogs can travel freely in the EU with their up-to-date passport no animal health certificate required. (each UK certificate can cost 250 pounds plus) if you wish to take your dog on holiday with you.

TOTAL INVESTMENT - 600.00

This is the cost for a breeder who ensures the puppy is immunized against all possible infections.

In the UK currently (law will change soon) a puppy goes to their new home with only the 40 day Parvo injection. We start with Parvo and Distemper as standard.



Our vaccination regime is without question the best you will find to ensure your puppy/young infant starts out with the best protection to infection possible.
